

COURSE LEVEL BY STUDENT RANK

Verification table under HEI reporting:

The following diagram shows relationships between COURSE LEVEL and STUDENT RANK for enrollment reporting & subsidy consideration. Rows show COURSE LEVEL and columns show STUDENT RANK abbreviations, values in the body of the table indicate the edit message (on the left for each rank column) and the proposed subsidy treatment for the enrollment (on the right for each column).

O indicates that the COURSE LEVEL and STUDENT RANK combination is within BOR's expectations.

W indicates a warning should be issued because that combination of COURSE LEVEL and STUDENT RANK is outside BOR's expectations.

E indicates this combination of COURSE LEVEL and STUDENT RANK would be excluded completely from subsidy calculations.

- ND = Non-Degree beyond Master-level
- PR = Professional (Dentistry, Optometry, Veterinary Medicine, Medicine)

General Rule:

When the course level is different from the subsidy level that is generated for this combination of course level and student rank, a Warning is issued.

There is one exception - When a Master's student takes a Doctoral-level course, they receive M subsidy.

Subsidy Level Key:

- V = Developmental (General Studies 2 subsidy)
- G = General Studies subsidy
- T = Technical subsidy
- B = Baccalaureate subsidy
- M = Masters subsidy (Including MPD 1)
- D = Doctoral subsidy
- P = Medical 1 or Medical 2 subsidy
