### Getting Started

*Tap Crestron Screen to Start:* If the Crestron screen is dark, tap it once to turn on.

Tap the on button to turn on the projector and lower the screen



### Using the Computer

If the computer isn't on, turn on the computer

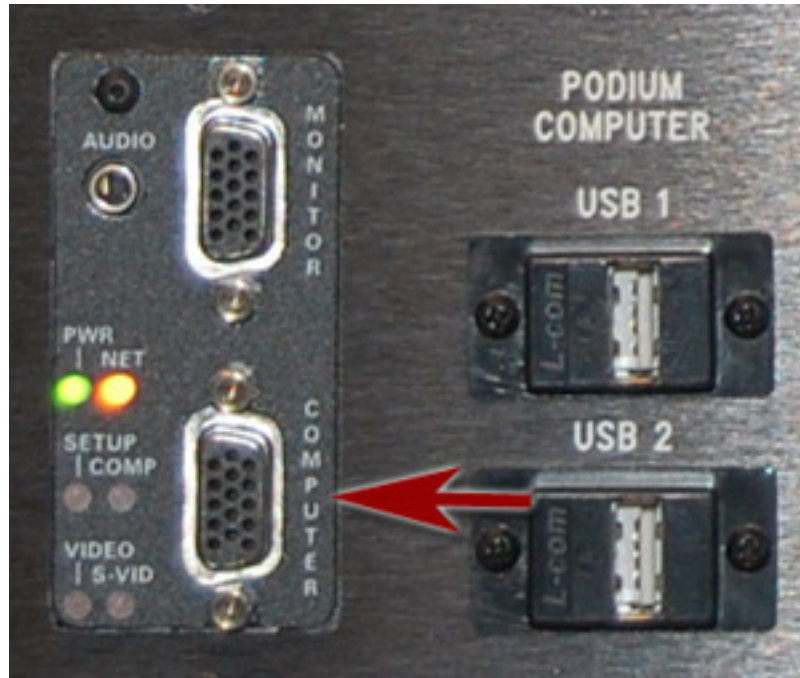


To log on:

- Select 'EHE Guest User'; no password is needed
- Tap the 'PC' button to view the computer screen on the projector.
- To access the Internet, you will first need to authenticate using your OSU Internet username and password (name.#).

## Using your own laptop

- Using provided VGA (RGB) cable, plug the cable into your laptop's RGB port and into the 'Computer' RGB port on the AV Tower



- Turn on Projector **THEN** turn on your laptop

**NOTE:** If you have an Apple Macbook or Macbook Pro you will need the DVI (or mini DVI) to RGB adaptor that came with your computer

## Using VCR/DVR



- Turn on DVD/VHS Player
- Tap the DVD or VHS button on the Crestron Screen
- Insert your disk or tape
- You can adjust the sound from the Crestron Screen.

**Once you are finished Please turn off the Projector by tapping the 'OFF' Button located on the main screen of the Crestron**
