SCHEDULING AND COURSE SEQUENCES ASSISTANCE

The following information is provided to guide students and advisors in developing curriculum plans.

1. GEC advice: Mathematics and Natural Science: (20 credits required)

- Take MATH 130 early (required for admission)
- Take BIOL 101 then Humn NTR 210
- For the remaining natural sciences, choose either a two-course sequence of physical sciences , OR one physical science and one additional biological science.

2. MAJOR AND SUPPORTING COURSE SEQUENCES:

- HM 350.01 → HM 460 → HM 551 and HM 552 → HM 650-661
HN 450 → HM 551 and HM 552
- CS&E 101 AND ECON 200 → BUS M&L 450 → HM 680
- CS&E 101 (or higher) → AMIS 310 → HM 560 → HM 561

3. INTERNSHIP SEQUENCING: (REQUIRES PERMISSION)

- HM 350.01 and HM 460 prerequisites for
 - HM 551 introductory foodservice internship
 - HM 552 introductory lodging internship
- HM 551 & HM 552 prerequisites for
 - HM 570 Advanced Internship requires

4. TAKE EARLY:

- HM 230 (should be taken very early in program, as it is a prerequisite to other courses in the program).
- CON SCI 310 (take HM 230 first)
- HM 400 (take HM 230 first)
- HM 700 (Sr. standing or permission)
