APPLICATION PROCESS (Only for first-time applicants to the Graduate School; others see reverse)

- <u>Online Graduate School Application</u>: Create an account through <u>http://gradadmissions.osu.edu/grad_apply.html</u>. Be sure to choose "Teaching and Learning – Ph.D." as the "Academic Program/Plan" and one of the specializations above for the "Sub Plan" in the "Program Data" tab of the application.
- <u>Transcripts</u>: Submit transcripts from each college or university attended other than OSU either to one of the addresses below OR submit electronically by uploading the documents to the online application. Include English translation of any foreign documents. Please <u>do not</u> send transcripts to the Department of Teaching & Learning.

- 3. <u>GRE (General Test)</u>: Required <u>for all Ed.S. and Ph.D. applicants regardless of undergraduate/graduate GPA</u>. The university will only consider scores official when reported electronically by ETS. Although there is not a minimum requirement, the following scores are considered competitive: Verbal = 150 or above, Quantitative = 150 or above, & Writing = 4.0 or above.
- 4. English Proficiency Test Score Requirements (International Applicants only): 550 on the Paper-Based TOEFL, 79 on the Internet-Based TOEFL, 82 on the MELAB, or 7 on IELTS. The university will only consider scores official when reported electronically by ETS. This is not a requirement for applicants who have or will have a bachelor's or higher degree from a country where English is the native language.
- 5. <u>Statement of Intent</u>: Please submit <u>electronically as a document attachment</u> to the online application. Must be typed, double-spaced, and no longer than 4 pages. The guidelines are highlighted below:
 - Intended Area of Study and Semester/Year of Enrollment
 - Autobiographical Information
 - Possible Research Interests
 - Educational & Professional Goals
 - To be considered for a Fellowship (University or Enrichment), please include a statement within the first paragraph of your document. For eligibility requirements, see the "FINANCIAL AID" section on the reverse side.
- 6. <u>Resume</u>: Please submit <u>electronically as a document attachment</u> to the online application. Must be typed and no longer than 2 pages. The guidelines are highlighted below:
 - Academic Background (degrees received/institutions attended)
 - Academic Accomplishments (scholarships, fellowships, awards, etc.)
 - Professional Experiences
 - Other Involvement, Service, Work experiences

- 7. Letters of Recommendation: Three letters are required. We prefer at least two academic letters of recommendation. In the "References" section on the "Final Steps/Submit" tab of the application, please request to have the letters submitted electronically by choosing "Yes" for the "Use Online Reference Form" option for each recommender. Each recommender will then receive an email with instructions once you complete and submit the application. Each recommender's electronic letter submission will include the Graduate School Reference Form.
- 8. <u>Academic Writing Sample</u>: Please submit <u>electronically as a document attachment</u> to the online application. Please <u>do not</u> submit lengthy theses or publications.

FINANCIAL AID

All Graduate School fellowships provide a monthly stipend, academic tuition and fees, and a subsidy of 85% of the student health insurance premiums. These fellowships are nonrenewable and may not be deferred.

<u>University Fellowship</u>: Tenure: 12 consecutive months; Monthly Stipend: \$1,435; Open to domestic & international students

Eligibility Requirements:

Cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.6 on 4.0 scale
GRE: 75th percentile average on GRE Verbal and Quantitative; 4.0 on Analytical Writing or GMAT: 75th percentile total score

Graduate Enrichment Fellowship: To recruit individuals who will bring diversity (broadly defined) to the Graduate School; Tenure: 12 consecutive months; Monthly Stipend: \$1,435; Open to domestic students only **Eligibility Requirements:** 1) Cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.1 on 4.0 scale

2) GRE: 40th percentile average on GRE Verbal and Quantitative; 3.5 on Analytical Writing or GMAT: 40th percentile total score

- ✓ If you are currently or have been previously enrolled as an OSU graduate student (this does not include Graduate Non-Degree), please refer to the process below in order to apply to transfer to T&L. <u>The application</u> process described on the first page of this checklist is only for first-time applicants to the Graduate School.

TRANSFER APPLICATION PROCESS

- <u>Request for Transfer of Graduate Program Form</u>: After completing Section 1 and obtaining the signature of the Graduate Studies Chair of your previous or current department, the form should be submitted to the Graduate School in 247 University Hall. The form can be found in the following link: <u>http://www.gradsch.ohio-state.edu/Depo/PDF/TransferGradProgram.pdf</u>.
- <u>T&L Transfer Application Packet</u>: This can be picked up from T&L Office of Academic Services Office. The packet includes the T&L Transfer Application, a request to your current or previous department to send a copy of your student file, and two reference forms.
- ✓ **<u>Statement of Intent</u>**: Please follow the same guidelines as first-time applicants to the Graduate School.
- ✓ **<u>Resume</u>**: Please follow the same guidelines as first-time applicants to the Graduate School.
- <u>Letters of Recommendation</u>: <u>Two</u> are required; the reference forms included in the T&L Transfer Application must be attached to each letter.
