Application to Graduate

Deadlines:

Undergraduate Students the second Friday of the quarter **prior** to graduation—*Application will be forwarded to Campbell Hall!*

Master's Students- the second Friday of the quarter **prior** to graduation—*September 30, 2011*

Doctoral Students-the second Friday of the quarter **of** graduation— *January 13, 2012*

Graduate students who can't make the deadline? Try the **end-of-quarter** options! What is the end-of-quarter option?—A student who does not meet published graduation deadlines but who does complete all degree requirements by the last business day prior to the first day of classes for the following quarter may graduate the following quarter without registering or paying fees. The student degree will not be conferred until the following quarter therefore, completed transcript or diploma will not be available until then.

DOCTORAL (PhD)

Notification of Final Oral Exam (http://www.gradsch.ohio-state.edu/Depo/PDF/Doc_Oral.pdf) is due two weeks prior to oral defense.

Please allow time for the Graduate Studies Committee Chair's signature (if applicable) on required documentation

Students must complete 120 hours to be eligible for graduation. 90 hours must be completed at OSU if you received.

- ◆ Complete application to graduate

- ◆ Must complete 50 hours-non-thesis
45 hours-thesis
- ◆ Complete paper work for all outstanding transfer credits (i.e. Grad Non-degree or Non-OSU) hours must be completed at OSU

HONORS GUIDELINE (UG students only)

To be eligible for honors, students must complete 90 hours at OSU.

Students who were admitted under the old program (before Summer 2007) will need to complete 196 hours. Students who were admitted Summer 2007 and beyond will need to complete 181
