1. **PLEASE DO NOT STAPLE MATERIALS TOGETHER.**
Please use a black or blue pen to complete this application.
2. **Application fee:**
Applicants must submit a check or money order for processing the application, payable to "**Treasurer, State of Ohio.**" (do not send cash).
Please note: \$25.00 of the processing fee is non-refundable if eligibility requirements for the license are not met.

2-Year License:
\$80.00 for the first license type, \$20.00 for each additional license type requested for the same effective year.

5-Year Professional License:
\$200.00 for the first license type, \$20.00 for each additional license type requested for the same effective year.

5-Year Associate License:
\$100.00

Adding a teaching field to an existing license:
\$20.00
3. **Effective Year:** An initial license may be backdated to July 1 of the current school year, or dated with the upcoming July 1 effective date.
4. **Legal Questions:** An application will not be processed unless all questions in this section are answered.
5. Applicants for an initial 2-Year Provisional Path B career-technical teaching license based on an evaluation by the superintendent of the employing school district (CTE-36) and admission to an approved 24-hour program at an Ohio college or university **must attach a completed CTE-37 form** signed by the district superintendent and the university official.
6. **Educational Level and Teaching or Administrative Experience:**
All applicants must fill out the education level and experience sections.
7. **School Counselor:** Individuals who have successfully completed all requirements for school counselor but do not evidence two years of classroom teaching under a standard teaching credential will be recommended for an initial two-year provisional license. The two-year provisional license for school counselor shall be required for entry into an induction year for school counselor.
8. **Signature of Recommending College Official.** Applications for those completing Ohio approved programs must be signed by the Ohio dean or head of teacher education verifying that the applicant has successfully completed the academic and experience requirements prescribed by the State Board of Education and the laws of Ohio.
9. **Equivalent Review by the Office of Educator Licensure.** Individuals who request the equivalent review for licensure must submit official transcripts evidencing all coursework completed for the new area; and a letter, on letterhead, from the employing superintendent or head of school verifying successful completion of a minimum of two years of mentored teaching under the Supplemental teaching license. Note: Individuals who received an evaluation for licensure through the supplemental pathway from this office may attach a copy of the evaluation with their application form
10. Applicants for the following licenses shall submit a photocopy of a currently valid license issued by the respective Ohio licensure board: **school audiologist, school social worker, school speech-language pathologist, school nurse, occupational therapist, physical therapist, occupational therapy assistant, and physical therapy assistant.**

In addition, applicants for occupational therapist and physical therapist must submit an official transcript evidencing a baccalaureate degree conferred. Applicants for occupational therapy assistant and physical therapy assistant must submit an official transcript evidencing an associate degree conferred.
