Description of Agency: This agency was formed to provide a variety of services for individuals and families in the community who are affected by diabetes. It is a well-run agency with supervisors who have experience working with field placement students. This is an agency with a variety of programs for family members of all ages. Programs such as education classes, support groups, case management, youth programs, day and summer camps are ongoing. Knowledge of diabetes is not necessary to begin a placement within this agency. Note: This site would also be available for one-quarter independent study or volunteer work.

Student Responsibilities: Specific projects and activities available for a placement student would include such opportunities as: Work on multi-disciplinary workshop/education sessions for teens with diabetes, conduct needs assessment interviews and follow-up, perform detection screening, develop curriculum for camp sessions, and conduct support groups.
