

# FEEP

## First Education Experience Program

- **What is FEEP?**

FEEP is a career exploration program designed for students interested in a career in education. The program will help you understand if a career in education is a good choice for you.

- **What careers can I explore?**

Students explore a variety of roles in FEEP, such as being a regular education or special education teacher, school counselor, school nurse, or any other type of professional educator as available.

- **If I register for FEEP, what does it require?**

FEEP is an 8 credit hour class that will expose you to the educational career of your choice. You will spend 4 days a week (for a total of 12 hours/week) with a school professional and 1 day a week in a seminar class. You will also need to get both a BCII AND FBI background check from the campus police station and provide a resume at orientation. The background checks are good for 1 calendar year, but they take several weeks to process so get them done ASAP.

- **How do I register?**

Registration for FEEP is held over the course of 3 weeks every quarter and takes each student approximately 15 minutes to complete. We register students a quarter in advance, so for example, students will register in the Autumn for participation in the Winter. All students must register through the FEEP program to obtain the call numbers in order to register online. Students may register in 1 of 2 ways:

- **Option 1: (BEST)** Submit your registration form online from the FEEP website (<http://ehe.osu.edu/paes/feep>). When your form has been received by the FEEP staff, you will be emailed the necessary course codes and other pertinent information that will enable you to prepare for the quarter.
- **Option 2:** The FEEP staff will set up tables for 2 2-hour windows every quarter—once in the Hale Center and once in Arps Hall lobby. Students may come to the table at any time during the 2-hour window and register in person. Students may also ask the FEEP staff questions at this time.
- **Option 3:** Students may download and print a registration form off of the FEEP website (<http://ehe.osu.edu/paes/feep>) and fill the form out completely. After completing the registration form, students can drop it off in the FEEP mailbox in room A426 of the PAES Building (305 W. 17<sup>th</sup> Ave.) during normal business hours. When the form is received by the FEEP staff, they will email the necessary course codes and information to each student to register online and prepare for the quarter.
- **Applications submitted after the open registration deadline will be applied to enrollment for the following quarter.**
