The purpose of the Pressey Honors Endowment Grant Program is to assist students who are candidates for graduation *with distinction* and who are not receiving other aid specifically designated for undergraduate research. The grant money must be used for budgeted items or travel specifically related to the research project. For example, laboratory expenses, computer time, and mailing costs are appropriate, while tuition, thesis duplication expenses or living expenses are not. The maximum amount for which students may apply is **\$750.00**, and we are able to fund just one request per student.

A faculty committee will review all requests and make recommendations.

This application should be submitted through your College Honors Director to Lisa Abrams, University Honors & Scholars Center, 220 West 12th Avenue. Awards are made **on a competitive basis**. The grant may be used either the quarter it is awarded or in a subsequent quarter, but students **must be enrolled** during the quarter in which they receive funding.
