Postdoctoral Researcher Travel Grant Program

Overview

The College of Education and Human Ecology (EHE), Office of Research provides travel support on a competitive basis to EHE postdoctoral researchers who present results of their research at national and international professional meetings. The EHE Office of Research funding support will match Departmental/School (D/S) funding up to a maximum of \$500. Each postdoctoral researcher is eligible to receive a travel grant once in a two year period. Application for a travel grant may be made by providing the information (outlined below) to the Associate Dean for Research in the EHE Office of Research. The award cycle for this program occurs three times throughout the year (see below).

Eligibility	EHE employees with classification of postdoctoral researchers
Frequency	Once every 2 years per postdoctoral researcher
Criteria	Presentation at a major domestic or international conference; overall research record; reference from the mentors. Other things being equal, preference will be given to first time applicants.
Amount	Up to a maximum of \$500 to equal the amount provided in matching funds by the D/S
Application Process	Submit all documentation by the deadlines noted below. March 1 for travel during April, May, June, July, August (Period 1) August 1 for travel during September, October, November (Period 2) November 1 for travel during December, January, February, March (Period 3)
Include	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. EHE Postdoctoral Researcher Travel Grant Application2. Invitation to present at the conference, including location and dates*3. Letter of support from Chair/Director confirming D/S matching support and amount4. Abstract of applicant's research presentation5. Curriculum vitae

*Meeting invitation may be submitted *after* application to travel award program if documentation has not yet been received by application deadline

Review

As soon as the application materials are received, an ad hoc committee and the EHE Associate Dean for Research will review each application.

Notification of Award

Award notification will be sent to the applicant and the D/S within 2 weeks after application deadline.

Accessing Funds

When approved, matching funds will be transferred to the postdoctoral researcher's D/S where they may be accessed by contacting the D/S fiscal officer.
