A 2.5 CPHR is required for most HDFS fieldwork courses, and for HDFS 565 (a requirement in Professional Specialization Area 1–Preschool Programming).

Transfer students can use appropriate transfer credit and grades for social science courses. Transfer students must earn a 2.0 CPHR from 15 credit hours at OSU prior to admission. (For the HDFS major only).

**If interested in the Master's of Education, a 3.0 CPHR is required to apply to the Ohio State M.Ed. program. A CPHR higher than a 3.0 improves competitiveness. The bachelor's program is a pre-teaching program and does not culminate in a teacher's license.
