NCATE/CAEP ACCREDITATION

PREPARATION FOR 2015 VISIT

In order to prepare for our NCATE/CAEP accreditation visit in spring of 2015, we have been requesting information from lecturers, cooperating teachers and area heads/program managers. We are trying to minimize the impact on your work and want you to know that we greatly appreciate your timely responses.

CONCEPTUAL FRAMEWORK

Can you help us prepare for the 2015 NCATE/CAEP visit? Now that the 2013 *The Ohio State University Educator Preparation Conceptual Framework* is official and here to stay, syllabi need to include applicable components. All courses that are part of preparing educators (professional, endorsements and

initial licensure) should include some of the following: Vision, Mission and/or applicable goals in the syllabus. A course is not required to have a Key Assessment in order to be aligned with or address some components of the Conceptual Framework.

NEW FORMS CREATED

FOR DISPOSITIONS

The UTEC Forms Subcommittee has developed a new disposition form to be used during admission to a program (initial, endorsement or advanced program). The State of Ohio is going to make a ruling that requires a dispositional assessment. The Forms Committee quickly developed a rubric that is flexible, brief and complete. See your program manager or your program Buckeye Box for a copy of the form.

UNIT-WIDE FORMS

A thank you to the UTEC Forms Subcommittee for developing Unit-wide forms for implementation this term, spring 2014. An MS Word version of the forms is available in each program's Buckeye Box. New forms are:

- Student teaching: there are two forms, Disposition and a 3-way, to be implemented twice during student teaching.
- Field Experience: there are two forms required for a field experience prior to student teaching; Disposition and a 3-way.

Consensus (Student Teacher, Cooperating Teacher and University Supervisor) student teaching data will be put into Tk20 by each program's University Supervisors. If you have questions, please contact Erica Brownstein at <u>brownstein.2@osu.edu</u>.

ADMISSION APPLICATIONS USING TK20

The Office of Educator Preparation has been working with program representatives to develop admission applications to be processed through Tk20 (without requiring purchase). So far, 24 applications have been completed, with four more in the prototype stage.
