FACULTY/STAFF SPOTLIGHT: DR. CHRIS ZIRKLE

Dr. Chris Zirkle serves as associate professor and program chair for Workforce Development and Education. He has three licensure programs –business education, career and technical education and school nurse, along with an endorsement program in career-based intervention. The career and technical education licensure program is unique in that it is the only program where students get a license "up-front" and backfill their OSU courses while they are employed as a teacher. This program has been at OSU

since the 1920's and currently has about 120 teachers.

Use of Data in Business Education

The Business Education program was one of the first to volunteer to pilot TK20 when it arrived at OSU. The Business Ed program used data collected through TK20, along with feedback from cooperating teachers, to make curricular adjustments, namely the addition of two business courses when they realized that students were not performing as well they would like on the PRAXIS content test or in student teaching. Being a small program, business education has close ties with local business teachers and the qualitative feedback they get from them, along with the quantitative data from TK20, gives a diversity of information to continuously improve the program.
