ANNOUNCING A NEW Tk20 TOOL

A new tool in Tk20 called the “Faculty Dashboard” provides course-based data analysis. The Dashboard:

- enables a quick gauge of class level and individual student performance
- provides a visual presentation of course-based data by term since 2010
- shows the status of student work and evaluation

Accessing the Dashboard

The Dashboard is accessed by selecting the Courses tab within Tk20.

A status bar is shown for each assessment per term. Each status bar has three different colors, each indicating a different student coursework status. Here is an example:



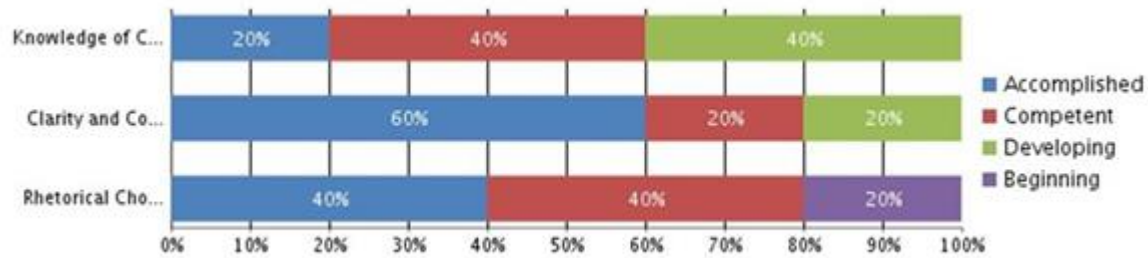
Green: Students that have submitted their assignments and their assessment is complete.

Yellow: Students that have submitted their assignments and have an assessment pending.

Red: Students that have not submitted their assignments.

Viewing a Report in the Dashboard

Click on the blue View Report button (as seen in status bar above) to see rubric results.



Real Time Hover Feature

Hovering a cursor on a number, as shown in the graph below, displays students within each category, and can be used to access individual student submissions.
