STATE OF OHIO UPDATE Teacher Shortage Areas

The Ohio Board of Regents ran data to ascertain the 2013-2014 teacher shortage areas by examining emergency licensure requests. Ohio-designated shortage areas for 2014 are four AYA areas (Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies), plus Foreign Language, Special Education, Speech Pathology and TESOL.

edTPA UPDATES edTPA Adoption

The State Technical Advisory Committee met on June 12 and 13 to discuss edTPA. It is hoped that there will be more information coming soon about edTPA as a license requirement. The assessment will continue to be required at Ohio State next year, and we anticipate that there will be a state-adopted cut score for licensure beginning in Autumn 2015.

Data Update

We have received scores for 337 candidates for the 2013-2014 academic year. Our average score across all programs is 44.2, which is above the national cut score recommendation of 37– 42. Our lowest average rubric was a 2.5 on *Rubric 13: Student Use of Feedback*. Our highest average rubric for all of our data was 3.4 on *Rubric 1: Planning for Content Understandings.* We should be very proud of our performance in the first full implementation year!

edTPA Terminology

Rapport: A close and harmonious relationship in which the people or groups understand each other's feelings or ideas and communicate well with each other.
