Tk20 TOOL REFRESHER / OVERVIEW

A new tool in Tk20 called the "Faculty Dashboard" provides course-based data analysis. The Dashboard:

- enables a quick gauge of class level and individual student performance
- provides a visual presentation of course-based data by term since 2010
- shows the status of student work and evaluation.

Accessing the Dashboard

The Dashboard is accessed by selecting the Courses tab within Tk20.

A status bar is shown for each assessment per term. Each status bar has three different colors, each indicating a different student coursework status. Here is an example:



Green: Students that have submitted their assignments and their assessment is complete. Yellow: Students that have submitted their assignments and have an assessment pending. Red: Students that have not submitted their assignments.

PROGRAM GATES FUNCTIONALITY ADDED

Another tool in Tk20 is being introduced to provide faculty and staff with additional insight into the progression of their candidates through their program. The Transition Points function in Tk20 allows programs to track candidates' achievement of defined milestones (commonly referred to as "Gates"). The Transition Points monitors four major evolutions in a candidate's professional preparation: 1) Admission to Program, 2) Acceptance to Student Teaching or Internship, 3) Successful Completion of Program, 4) Recommendation for Licensure.

Throughout January 2015, information and instructions on how to access, review and update details within Transition Points 1 and 2 will provided to all program representatives. The advanced functionally of Points 3 and 4 will be rolled out later in the semester.
