STUDENT TEACHER SURVEY

Please verify the completion of the OBR preservice survey by your student teachers. The survey is sent by the Ohio Board of Regents and the data are reported to programs each semester. Results are used for the Ohio Metrics Performance Report and are part of the funding calculations. The survey was sent out mid-March. A reminder will be sent Friday, March 27.

COOPERATING TEACHER/ MENTOR SURVEY

Can you help us collect information from your P-12 cooperating teachers/mentors? The Cooperating Teacher/Mentor survey has been sent to P-12 school personnel. We only collect data from those that did not respond in fall 2015.

Will you ask your candidates/interns to reach out to their mentors and encourage them to complete the survey? The survey is short and asks about professional experience and demographics, which is required for our accreditation process.

BACKGROUND CHECKS AND SUPERVISORS

According to school districts and the new Ohio State Minor's policy, personnel that enter schools for the purpose of supervising Ohio State students do not need to complete background checks. School districts request supervisors sign in as "visitors" each time they enter a building.

The policy only applies if one is alone with a minor.

"Tools for the Process: Helping Candidates Help Themselves"

Below is an edTPA tip for candidates from Nancy Cunniff Casey, St. Bonaventure University. Nancy sends weekly support messages to her teacher candidates. Feel free to share with your students!

Tip #5: General Tips & Getting Started

Make a folder structure. Start by creating a folder for your files – and name it carefully. Consider putting on your desktop for easy access. Within that folder, make folders for each of the edTPA tasks. There will be three folders. The very first thing you should do is copy the CURRENT edTPA template files and put them in the correct folders. Then, as you work, save all files into the correct folder. Follow the directions in the Evidence Chart in your Handbook EXACTLY. Note that you should rename the templates with "PART_" at the beginning to align with the Evidence Chart.
