### OAE COMPETENCY RESULTS AVAILABLE

Pearson is now releasing competency level results for our programs and for candidates that do not pass the Ohio Assessments for Educators (OAE) tests. These results will enable programs to examine content competencies and evaluate strengths and weaknesses in the preparation of candidates. Additionally, for candidates that do not pass the OAE, detailed analysis will be available for use by programs. The "look" of test results in Buckeye Box will be slightly different than it is now, to accommodate the new data.

Below you will find student loan default rates from 2010 and 2011, the latest available. The student loan default rate is for graduates, and generally indicates job placement. ### TK20 UPDATES

#### TK20 Interactive Conference, Austin, Texas

The Tk20 Interactive Conference (June 8-11) featured dozens of training sessions and conference discussions with members of the Tk20 family and many from across the Tk20 community. Some of the presenters this year included Ohio State's Robert Hampton and Jacob Chacko. They presented

**Organizational Hierarchy: Helping to Make "Big" Usefully "Small"**, in which they discussed how OSU's Office of Educator Preparation uses the Organizations function in Tk20 to help manage admissions, assessment, and transition points reporting solutions across a Teacher Education Unit spanning four divisional groupings (colleges), 46+ programs on 5 campuses, and servicing 1200 candidates and another 1800 pre-majors.



**Robert Hampton** is the Director of Teacher Accreditation for the College of Education and Human Ecology's Office of Educator Preparation at The Ohio State University. He works closely with the various Teacher Education programs in crafting data collection and program development solutions to meet the various Federal, State and Professional standards and licensing requirements. He also works to extend the capabilities of Unit Assessment System by designing tighter integration structures among the various data platforms and systems (including Tk20).



**Jacob Chacko** is the Quality Data Manager for the College of Education and Human Ecology's Office of Educator Preparation at The Ohio State University. He is part of a team that designs, develops and deploys quality management and reporting systems, as well as serves as an educational resource towards compliance, assurance and the reporting processes. His primary role is integrating multiple university data systems, including the Tk20 platform, to implement solutions for use by the Educator Preparation Unit.

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## PRAXIS UPDATE

For programs that still use Praxis II tests, there will be a test price increase of five dollars and a score report increase of ten dollars that will go into effect on June 1, 2015.
