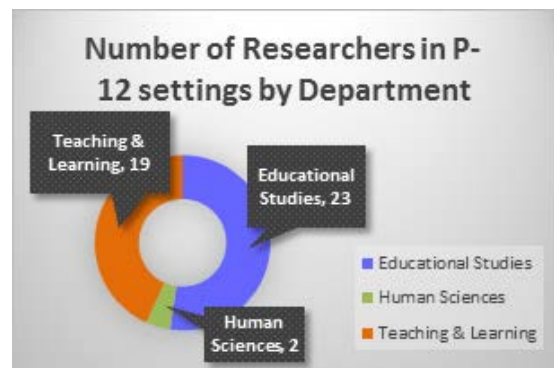

HOW MUCH RESEARCH IS CONDUCTED IN SCHOOLS BY EHE?

The magic number is 9840 hours of research. Yes, 9840 hours were conducted in schools by EHE faculty, instructors, post docs, staff and students in 2014-2015. Most (8343) were exchanged for fee authorization credits (vouchers) for use by eligible schools in Franklin County. We have outstanding researchers that are able to partner with collaboratively-minded school districts. Data were obtained from the annual survey through the Office of Research.



These hours help school districts earn fee authorizations to take courses in the College of Education and Human Ecology. Thank you for reporting!

OAE UPDATES

Early Childhood Education OAE

Data analysis of 2014-2015 test takers for the Ohio Assessments for Educators (OAE) tests were reviewed by the Ohio Educator Standards Board. The Early Childhood Education Test (Test #12) had a 98% pass rate. The target pass rate for the state is 89%. Therefore, the standard error of measurement (raw score required for passing) was increased. Last year, 100% of our candidates passed this test. Bottom line: The raw cut score is higher (the score candidates see will remain 220).

Secondary Biology, Secondary Language Arts, and Early Childhood Special Education

Results showed these tests had less than the targeted 89% pass rate. The Educator Standards Board recommended lowering the raw cut score, but was not approved by the State Board of Education. Last year, Ohio State first time test taker results were all less than the targeted 89% for these tests. Bottom line: Support your candidates as they prepare for these tests.

WHERE OH WHERE IS THE DATA?
