EVIDENCE REQUIRED FOR DATA DRIVEN DECISIONS

The new CAEP accreditation standards emphasize data-driven decisions. Each program is expected to provide evidence of regular, consistent data-driven decisions. The format of that evidence may be in meeting minutes, videos of data discussions, etc. A new form, Data Driven Decisions Evidence Form, is available in each program's Buckeye Box as well as Carmen.

MUSIC ED STUDENTS BENEFIT FROM CURRICULAR CHANGES

First year students enrolling in music education will now complete an early field experience that is specifically designed for music education majors. TEACHER SHORTAGE AREAS

For individuals that complete programs that are listed as shortage areas for Ohio, they may be eligible for Federal Perkins Loan cancellation of up to 100 percent of loan repayment. Areas for this year in Ohio are: AYA English/Language Arts, Foreign Languages, AYA Mathematics, AYA Science (any area), AYA Social Studies, Special Education (any area), Speech/Language Pathology, Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL).
