

HOW DO OSU STUDENTS COMPARE WITH THE REST OF THE STATE?

Have you wondered how our students compare with the rest of the state on the OAE Assessment of Knowledge of Pedagogy? Below is a summary of the percentage correct in each of the ten competencies assessed. While Ohio State averages exceeded the state averages in all areas, the most significant percentage difference (four percent) was in the Various Instructional Approaches.




One area to consider targeting for improvement is the constructed response question writing pertaining to the "Learning Processes" competency. edTPA UPDATES

2014 edTPA Administrative Report Released

The Stanford Center for Assessment, Learning and Equity (SCALE), the American Association of Colleges of Teacher Education (AACTE) and Evaluation Systems group of Pearson released the 2014 Administrative Report, which presents performance data from 18,000+ candidates who participated in edTPA during 2014. Also presented are: analyses affirming reliability of scoring; validity evidence supporting its intended use as a measure of readiness to teach; and as a metric to inform program approval or accreditation. Analyses and results have been reviewed by a technical advisory committee of nationally recognized psychometricians, and thus meet technical standards for licensure assessments set forth by AERA, APA, & NCME (2014).
