CAEP CORNER: EVIDENCE IS KEY

For our accreditation, each element of each standard must have multiple (i.e., minimum of three) pieces of evidence. However, one piece of evidence may be applicable to multiple standards. For example, in visualizing edTPA as a pie, individual components of the assessment provide evidence for multiple elements of multiple standards:

Training Available for Unit-Wide Student Teaching Form

Are you a supervisor or faculty member using the Unit-Wide Student Teaching Form to assess student teachers' performance in spring 2016? Ask your program manager/faculty lead about the Form training.

Training may be completed at the trainee's own pace, and should take no more than three hours. It was developed by OSU supervisors from multiple programs and:

- discusses the organization and structure of the Form.

- describes how the Form is used to assign scores/develop goals (e.g., when to assign a '2' instead of a '3,' why 'N/A' is not a permissible row score);

- provides practice scoring opportunities; and

- models a midterm/final Three-Way Conference.

How might you support your candidates? Send them messages! Below is a tip from Nancy Cunniff Casey from St. Bonaventure University.

Task Tip: Model the Intended Learning

When teaching lessons and reviewing video to choose clips, be sure to MODEL the intended learning. Don't just TELL your students to do something, SHOW them. Show how you solve the problem, read a text for meaning or find the evidence. That is good teaching. Students need to see what tasks look like in action.
