HOW THE ED PREP VOUCHER IS USED?

Effective autumn semester 2015, students accepted as undergraduate majors and enrolled in initial teacher licensure programs are automatically enrolled in the Educator Preparation Voucher program. This voucher fee enables student costs from edTPA, Tk20, and the Ohio Assessment for Educators (OAE) tests (or the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages tests) to become part of their financial aid package. Inclusion of the voucher fee on the OSU fee statement provides flexibility for payment of expenses with financial aid dollars, and distributes expenses over four semesters.

Students can view their statements, including the Educator Preparation Voucher fee, on BuckeyeLink.

Do you have a student considering a profession in education?

If so, they should plan to complete FEEP (First Education Experience Program). We encourage our students to complete FEEP as early as possible, as this experience helps them determine if a career in the K-12 setting is a good fit. edTPA UPDATES

Sharing of Completed edTPA Portfolios

Completed portfolios can be shared with faculty for program improvement purposes. It is recommended that whole portfolios or whole answers to a prompt should not be

discussed. Portions of answers, with student permission, can be shared and discussed. The discussion would not be to verify the scoring, but as a point of discussion with the class. No videos should be shared, because permission would require special permission from each parent.

As a disclaimer, sometimes the guidelines change.

“Helping Candidates Help Themselves”

How might you support your candidates? Send them messages! Below is a tip from Nancy Cunniff Casey from St. Bonaventure University.

Task Tip: Use the Video Analysis Tool

Once finished teaching your lessons, choose video clips to analyze. Video clips should show:

- Respect and rapport with your students
- Respect between and among students
- Use of students' prior knowledge and assets
- Modeling the strategy you are teaching
- Students engaged in learning

Examine video clips using a video analysis tool, watch and time stamp the original videos. Find the video clip that includes the requirement described in your handbook.
