

Getting to Know the CAEP Standards: Standard 1.2

CAEP Standard 1 focuses on candidates' "Content and Pedagogical Knowledge." Standard 1.2 requires that "Providers ensure that candidates use research and evidence to develop an understanding of the teaching profession and use both to measure their P-12 students' progress and their own professional practice.

CAEP requires EPPs to provide multiple measures of evidence from valid and reliable instruments. At present, OSU plans to provide evidence for this standard from...



QUALIFICATIONS FOR COOPERATING TEACHERS

Our Cooperating Teachers (CTs) are a vital resource for our Educator Preparation programs. They provide ongoing support while modeling best practice for the preservice candidate. They have a history of being highly skilled and effective teachers, and play a critical role in the development of the candidates' skills. The CTs must:

- Have a minimum of three years of P-12 teaching experience
- Hold a current license for the content area that the student teacher is studying
- Be recommended by the building principal and program manager
- Be approved by the district

Another Task Tip: Giving Feedback

If one of your objectives is "The students will **compare and contrast** two versions of Sleeping Beauty, including discussion of character and setting", your feedback might say something like: "I am impressed that you were able to point out such detailed differences in the characters. That's a great job at CONTRASTING. But did you find any similarities? Remember that comparing means finding how two things are the same." You need to give feedback related to this learning objectives.
