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OEP WELCOMES JOSH MAHER

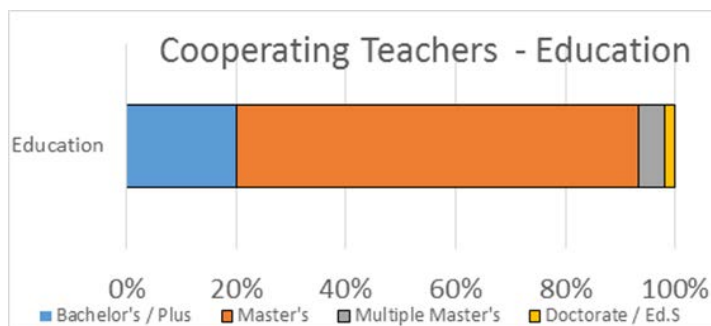
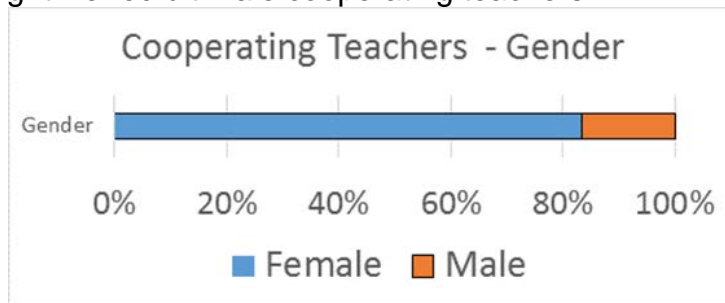

MENTOR/COOPERATING TEACHER SURVEY

The Fall 2016 Cooperating Teacher (CT) Survey was distributed on Wednesday, October 19 with a completion deadline of Friday, November 4. Currently, 44.8 percent of people have responded. More information about how you can help us meet our goal (80%) will arrive in your inbox soon.

The Spring 2016 CT Survey yielded 336 responses. Who supports our student teachers? The graphs below give a quick glimpse of the gender and education breakdown of the group. We look forward to sharing more detailed results with you from the Spring and Fall 2016 CT Surveys soon.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE VOUCHER PROGRAM

How will students receive their OAE and edTPA voucher codes?

By the third week of the semester, students will receive an email from OEP with their OAE and edTPA voucher code that includes directions to redeem it and the expiration date. Each student's OAE/edTPA voucher codes may also be found at the bottom of their Basics tab in Tk20.

ARE YOUR STUDENTS ELIGIBLE FOR TEACH GRANTS?

The Federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) grant is awarded to students that earn licenses in high need fields and will teach in low income schools. For Ohio, high need fields are: Arts; English/Language Arts; Foreign Languages; AYA Mathematics; AYA Science; AYA Social Studies; Special Education – all fields; Speech/Language Pathology; and TESOL.

An online tool to help is: <http://imtranslator.net/translate-and-speak/default.asp>. You can even slow down the speech, read along on your hard copy, and mark up your work.
