FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE VOUCHER PROGRAM

How can students tell if they are in the voucher program?

Students in the voucher program will see an Ed Prep Voucher fee listed on their Bursar bill. Undergrads will be assessed the \$128.50 fee for four semesters, which will cover a Tk20 account (1st semester), one OAE test (2nd semester) and edTPA (3rd/4th semesters). Grads will be assessed the \$135.00 fee for three semesters, which will cover a Tk20 account (1st semester) and edTPA (2nd/3rd semesters). Note: Timing is an important factor, so a student finishes early or enters late, please flag this for our office.

Faculty and staff questions should be directed to <u>Kathleen Lynch</u>. Students should check their Bursar bill first.



ODE Changes Wait Time

The Ohio Department of Education has changed how long licensure applications will be held within the ODE SAFE application system. Previously the hold limit was 180 days- the new hold limit is 60 days. If you have questions on how this affects your students, please contact Casey Hammond.

REMINDER: FERPA TRAINING FOR THOSE WITH ACCESS TO DATA OR STUDENT INFORMATION



edTPA UPDATE

Autumn 2016 edTPA Scores

edTPA scores for autumn 2016 student teachers are in! Across all programs and campuses (n=95), the average overall score was 44.52 with an average rubric score of 3.0. Furthermore, averages by tasks are: 1) Planning – 15.4, 2) Instruction – 14.6 and 3) Assessment – 15.0. See the data visualization below for the average by rubric.
