

On October 6, 82 new OAE scores were received and updated in your program's Buckeye Box. Sixty-six met the 220 threshold for a 80.5% pass rate.

DIVERSITY INFORMATION ON OHIO PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Are you wondering which school buildings are diverse? The Office of Ed Prep developed a resource for programs based on ODE and NCES data.

Faculty and staff consistently make it a priority to place our students in diverse P-12 field experiences. A school is considered diverse in four categories if their student demographics meet or exceed the state mean/thresholds listed. All public schools in the state are included in this file, located in the Ed Prep Unit Information Buckeye Box <u>here</u>. (Note: private schools and preschools will be added at a later date.)

Diversity Category	State Threshold	National Threshold
Disability (Special Education)	14.5%	12.9%
Economically Disadvantaged	49.9%	48.0%
Limited English Proficient	2.7%	9.3%
Ethnicity/Race (Non-White)	28.9%	35.7%

SUPPORT FOR CANDIDATES TAKING LICENSURE TESTS

Many candidates have strong potential as educators but struggle to pass the licensure tests. For some students, it is helpful to offer practice tests and feedback to help combat their test anxiety. One of AACTE's affiliate members, Teachers Test Prep, offers free online diagnostics and other services to help candidates improve their exam performance. They receive an instant diagnostic breakdown indicating their strengths and weaknesses, and their overall likelihood of passing. Identifying at–risk students early on is the key to providing the support these students need for success.

If a program chooses to use this service, a designated administrator will also receive compiled reports to help identify at-risk students.

How will students receive their OAE and edTPA voucher codes?

By the third week of each semester, student teachers will receive an email from OEP with their OAE and edTPA voucher codes. Directions on how to redeem the vouchers and the expiration dates are included.

Each student's OAE/edTPA voucher code is also available at the bottom of their Basics tab in Tk20.
