OAE SCORES POSTED TO BUCKEYE BOX

Recently, new OAE scores were posted to your program's Ed Prep Buckeye Box. Of the 139 tests taken, 109 students received a passing score for an overall pass rate of 78.4%. Performance on the new 090 Foundations of Reading test was 68.4% (13 of 19 passed). The next round of OAE results will be posted by Friday, May 26.

PROGRAM DATA DAYS COMING SOON!

To support program review of your 2016-17 assessment data, OEP is hosting four optional data days – May 23, May 24, June 6 and August 15. Program leads were contacted with this information a few weeks ago, but if you have not had a chance to sign up, it's not too late! We are also happy to join any of your faculty meetings.

If you would like to review your data at your own program faculty meeting, we will prepare the handouts/data charts with approximately two weeks in advance.

BACKGROUND CHECKS – WHAT IF A STUDENT DOESN'T MEET THE STATE REQUIREMENTS?

Please remember, part of the *entrance* to a program is the need to pass both FBI & BCI&I background checks that match the criteria set forth by the screening tool of Ohio Department of Education. It is respectful to the student to assess the background check of candidates *as soon as possible* so students are not taking courses that lead to a licensure in which they are not qualified to obtain.

As a reminder, it is the program's responsibility to notify the student of the reason(s) why they are not eligible to be a part of the program based on this criteria.
