CAEP Self Study Report Part 1: EPP Overview

Work has begun on the Educator Preparation Program (EPP) Self-Study Report, due to CAEP by March 9, 2018. The draft EPP Overview, sections B,C, and D, were distributed at the August 4 UTEC meeting. Several changes

were suggested, including defining EPP, explaining the purpose of each UTEC subcommittee, and defining the term “candidate.”

Autumn 2017

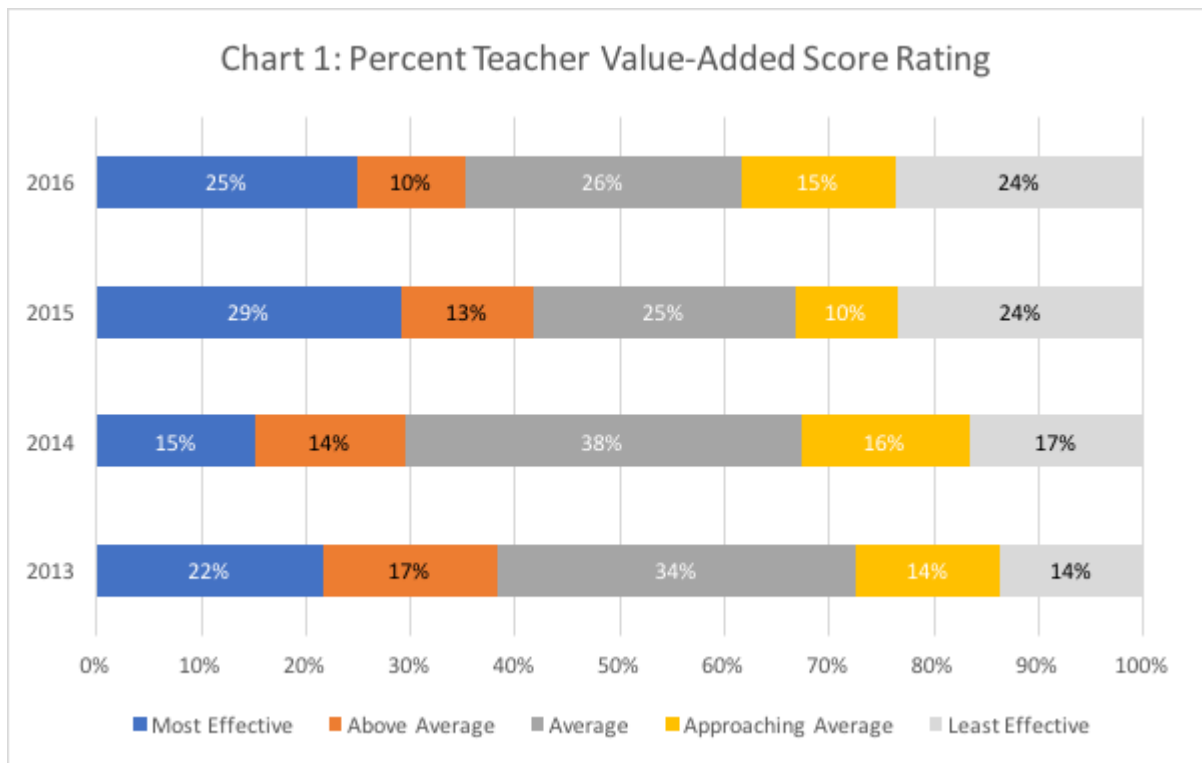
OEP received 165 OAE scores from Pearson this month. The average overall test score was 241.3 with an 82% passing rate. Both the overall 16-17 reporting year scores for students and Autumn 2017 student teaching files have been updated in your Data for [Program] > OAE data folder on Buckeye Box.

ODHE UPDATE

OSU Alumni Value-Added Results from 2012-13 to 2015-16

ODHE recently provided additional data on Value-Added Scores of Ohio State alumni who graduated recently and are teaching in Ohio public schools. It allows us to see the percent of teachers performing at each level (Chart 1 below) as well as the percent of teachers employed in poverty and minority schools. The data is provided in an anonymous form, and therefore cannot be further broken down by programs and campuses.

UTEC TEACHER EDUCATION ADMISSION GUIDELINES

University Teacher Educational Council (UTEC) members developed admission guidelines for teacher preparation programs at Ohio State. Guidelines include criteria and three options:

1. Direct enrollment from high school
2. Program admission for current OSU students
3. Program admission for students entering OSU as transfer students or through an articulation agreement.

Each campus and program may use the guidelines to develop their own criteria for direct admission.
