Ohio State Initial Employer Perceptions Survey Results


CAEP Accountability Measure #2: Satisfaction of Employers and Stakeholder Involvement

Employer satisfaction surveys are used to gather input from targeted principals and district representatives in Ohio public schools who employ recent Ohio State initial licensure completers within their first four years. Questions ask responders to rate the effectiveness of the completers preparation in 15 key areas, with a 3.0 mean indicting general agreement. The Administrator survey is distributed by OSU to targeted school leaders while the Partner survey¹ is shared with district partners who also accept Ohio State candidates in field experiences.
