Please be aware that the login page for the APL Application has changed its appearance because of updated features. Please use the Ohio State Employee Login on the left, which will take you to the Application Suite as usual.

Ed Prep Voucher Program Changes

The voucher program is undergoing changes in the 2022-23 year. It is shifting to a one-time, \$95 fee for the **incoming graduate and undergraduate cohorts**. The voucher will cover the Tk20 student account. All OAE tests should be paid for out of pocket. The new fee amount will take effect in Autumn 2022; therefore, Summer 2022 charges remain under the previous structure.

How it will impact current students with Summer 2022 charges:

- Incoming M.Ed. students will receive a \$40 refund
- Current undergraduate students who got their first fee will receive a \$33.50 refund

The original fee structure includes enrolled students from previous cohorts. They will continue to receive one OAE voucher and the \$300 reimbursement for their unused edTPA voucher.

OAE Costs

Ohio Assessments for Educators (OAE) prices will increase from \$105/assessment (\$56/subtest) to \$109/assessment (\$59/subtest) beginning approximately September 1, 2022. Coupled with these price updates are several new and enhanced services that will be offered and available on the OAE website, including the implementation of a new test fee waiver program for those with financial needs. If students are using a previously assigned OAE voucher to purchase a test (\$105 value), they must cover the additional cost out-of-pocket.
