
about these placements should be filled out on a placement template with special attention to choosing the correct drop-down in the following three columns.

## **SPRING 2019 OEP OPEN FORUM FOLLOW-UP**

At the recent Open Forum, participants analyzed OTES data trends and discussed potential unit-wide goals. They were pleased to see over time, OSU graduates performed at the *Skilled/Accomplished* levels at a greater rate than the State benchmarks. Also, there were year-to-year positive trends with increasing percentages of teachers scoring at the highest level of *Accomplished* and decreasing percentages of teachers at the lower level of *Developing*.

The group recommends a future goal focused on decreasing the percentages of OSU graduates in the Developing category, especially first and second-year teachers. # LICENSURE UPDATES

Early Childhood (P-3) License Holders: Recent Licensure Grade-Band Changes Will Not Affect Current Licensees

The recently enacted Ohio Senate Bill 216 eliminates the Early Childhood P-3 license and replaces it with a P-5 license. However, teachers who currently hold a P-3 license will

continue to renew that license as it is. Also, current P-3 license holders will continue to have two options for adding grades 4 and 5 to that license.

- Option one: Those not teaching grades 4 or 5 now will have to complete an approved teacher preparation program through an accredited college or university to add the 4-5 Generalist endorsement.
- Option two: Those teaching grades 4 or 5 now can apply for a supplemental 4-5 Generalist endorsement at the request of the school where they teach, and complete the supplemental pathway through the Ohio Department of Education.

## **How to Apply for Licensure: What to Tell Students**

- Please encourage them to submit applications after April 15.
- OEP cannot process the applications until after graduation.
- Students may apply online at https://safe.ode.state.oh.us/portal.

- The cost to apply is \$160.
- It is the candidates' responsibility to ensure their background checks will be current when applying for a license. Please refer them to: <a href="http://ehe.osu.edu/educator-preparation/background-checks/">http://ehe.osu.edu/educator-preparation/background-checks/</a>.
- Records will be reviewed for completion of internal processes\* and graduation. If students meet all requirements and the application is accurate and correct, they will be recommended for license usually within 30 days.
  - \*includes verification of test scores, field placement documentation, Ohio Standards and/or Opioid Module, department approval, etc.

We would like to encourage programs to remind your students to complete the surveys. Many institutions near 100% completion each semester, and we wish to push towards this goal!

The survey is sent via qualtrics.com on behalf of ODHE. If you have any students who believe they have not received the link, please have them check their Junk/Spam folders or have them contact Joshua Maher (maher.93@osu.edu) for assistance.

Survey results are publicly shared on the State Educator Preparation Performance Report Card, our website, and reported to CAEP. Links are unique to each individual's email, so they are not able to share links with classmates.
