CAEP Accountability Measure #2: Satisfaction of Employers and Stakeholder Involvement

A satisfaction survey is used to gather input from targeted principals and district representatives in Ohio public schools who employ recent Ohio State initial licensure completers within their first four years. Questions ask responders to rate the effectiveness of the completers preparation in 15 key areas, with a 3.0 mean indicting general agreement. Results are used for program evaluation and improvement.
