A copy of the final product will be submitted to the Graduate School. An oral examination is required and must be conducted by the student's Ed.S. committee (minimum length, 90 minutes). All Ed.S. students are required to register for **3 credit hours of Research hours (EDUTL 8999) in the term of graduation**.
