Program managers, please inform your current candidates not to apply to ODE for their license until mid to late April. We recently had to decline a few applications as it is too early and their application will expire (60 days) before they are eligible. Candidates cannot be approved until May 6 (2018 spring graduation) and with the high volume at that time, there is no guarantee when their application will be approved.

TK20 Data Restrictions

Per OCIO Institutional Data Policy, <u>Restricted (S4) data cannot be stored within</u> <u>TK20</u>. Therefore, please review the Data Element Classification Assignments listed below to make sure you're familiar with the TK20 data restrictions:

Restricted Data (S4) Elements:

- Name + Social Security Number
- Name + Driver's License Number
- Name + State ID Card Number
- Name + Financial Account Numbers + Access Code
- Debit or Credit Card Cardholder Data
- Student Treatment Record
- Protected Health Information
- Export Controlled Data
- Student Loan Application Data

- Financial Account Data Associated with Student Loans
- Password, Private Encryption Key, and Identity Management Database or Repository
- Risk and Information Security Assessments
- Med Center Badge ID
- BuckID Database or Repository
- Bank Account + Routing Number
- FAFSA/ISIR data in its entirety

If you come across Restricted (S4) data while in TK20 (i.e. reviewing applications, assessment uploads, etc.), please contact Robert Hampton (https://nampton.11@osu.edu) with detailed information about its location so the proper steps can be taken for it to be removed.

If you work with students regarding a process where they are required to upload documents, please remind them to be cautious about what information they include. Additionally, OEP will post a student-facing document to provide guidance on Restricted (S4) data within Tk20 for their reference.
