Principals and HR personnel from 11 school districts (urban, suburban, rural, elementary, middle high school, public, and charter) were interviewed during the 2017-2018 school year. Results include categories such as Accolades and Areas to Improve. Select quotes below. Emphasis and color font were added.

Accolades:

- "Ohio State hires are high quality, knowledgeable in content and pedagogy, and great at classroom management."
- "Ohio State leads the way by having District/Program Manager Meetings."
- "OSU students are prepared to make an *immediate impact*, as shown in OTES scores."
- "Possess a high level of knowledge and ways to integrate technology in lessons."

Areas to Improve:

- "Increase providing strategies in communication and developing relationships with students, including how to identify and develop socio-emotional skills in learners."
- "Increase the Early Childhood students understanding of special education."

Overall impression of novice teachers from Ohio State:

- "Ohio State develops the most prepared teachers in Ohio as I also do a lot of recruiting for our district. I will do the entire Teach Ohio job fair circuit and as I begin I am disappointed. I might hire 3-5 but when I get to Ohio State it is like 16 out of 18 interviews I am ready to hire."
- "They are aware of *all the diversity* areas not just race and color but gender equity, ELL, special education, socio-economic."
- "The OSU graduates have always been *professional* and is one of the things that sets them apart from others."

edTPA FOCUS GROUP

A special thank you to Ohio State representatives on the edTPA Focus Group meetings: Terri Bucci, Caryn Filson, Terri Hessler, and Linda Parsons. There was majority support with a recommendation for licensure requirement if it replaces the Assessment of Professional Knowledge (APK). Participants expressed concern about the stress candidates experience and the overall cost, they felt the benefits outweighed these. The recommendation was made to the Chancellor, who supported it and sent to ODE for their action.

edTPA & OAE SCORES POSTED

The most recent round of edTPA and OAE scores have been posted to your Ed Prep program's Buckeye Box. Please check your Data folders for your students' scores.

During the spring 2018 semester, we have received 164 edTPA scores so far, with the overall average score of 42.6 points. In late-February, we received 82 OAE scores, 17 of which were for the Foundations of Reading assessment. The overall pass rate was 83% with a 76.4% pass rate for the reading content test.

AVERAGE PROGRAM LOAD DEBT

It shows the Average Load Debt by cohort year, based on spring graduating cohorts. The average amount of borrowers over 5 years is \$26,212.
