A big **thank you** to everyone who helped us with the CAEP team visit! Details and summary of the visit will be reported in our next newsletter. Final recommendations will be determined by the CAEP Accreditation Council in the spring. There were approximately 130 individuals (students, alumni, faculty, staff, instructors, supervisors, and P-12 partners) interviewed by the CAEP Team.

Comments from the CAEP team leader include, "We were so impressed with the number of individuals who attended the focus groups, both from the community and within the university," and "This is the most organized report I have ever seen."

Are You an OSU Employee with an Ohio Teaching License?

If you are an Ohio State employee and would like to renew your Ohio teaching license(s)/endorsements, Ohio State has an active Local Professional Development Committee (LPDC) that may help. For those with licenses due to expire on June 30, 2019, you may wish to begin the renewal process with the OSU LDPC now, by contacting Christine Fagan, Licensure and Graduation Coordinator.

Licensure Applicants

Please remind your students to be aware of when to apply for licensure on the ODE website. Applications are valid for 60 days. Autumn 2018 graduation is December 16. If students are waiting on test scores, they may want to wait to make certain they have passed before applying. Additionally, please remind them to be patient for approval, as many applications are received around graduation, and also depend on the complexity of the license being requested.

Spring and summer term 2019 graduates should count backwards 60 days from the day of graduation, then add a few weeks for approval processing time. Spring semester has the greatest number of graduates, so waiting until the halfway point in the semester is advisable, as is waiting to make sure they have passed any required OAE tests.



Monitoring Supervisors Data in Tk20

Would you like to know if your university supervisors have entered Pre-CPAST, CPAST, or Observation documents for their students into Tk20? Or what data they have entered into Tk20?

Here is a step-by-step guide on how to login as the university supervisor to view the data they have inputted into Tk20:

- 1. Change access to Program Coordinator (using the dropdown located top left under your name)
- 2. Click on the Administration menu option from the list of items on the left
- 3. Select Users to search for someone and then login as them using the Log in button
- 4. Note: Contact Jacob Chacko at chacko.7@osu.edu if you need access to Tk20 as a Program Coordinator.

When and how can students add a course?

Students may add a course through Buckeye Link until the **first Friday** of every semester. After the first Friday, they need permission from the instructor.

What counts as permission? An email from the instructor giving the student permission to enroll is sufficient through the **second Friday** of the semester.

What happens after the second Friday? Students are required to complete:

- 1. A "late add" petition and
- 2. Submit a Course Enrollment Permission Form. The Course Enrollment Permission Form requires signatures from the

instructor and the department offering the course.

edTPA and OAE Scores

AU18 edTPA results are coming in! As of early December, we received 33 new scores with the overall mean of 43.6 points. New scores have been posted to your program's Ed Prep>Data for [Program]>edTPA Data folders. As a reminder, you can check your students' edTPA submission status in the Ed Prep: Unit Information folder to ensure portfolios are received by Pearson.

The latest round of OAE scores was posted December 3. Scores are from tests taken October 22 to November 18, 2018. Both the 2018-19 Student Teaching file (tests for only STs across all years) and 2018-19 Program Scores file (tests from this academic year only) are updated monthly.

Educators Rising national competitions are performance-based competitive events in which aspiring teachers demonstrate their knowledge, skills, and leadership in education. Students from all over Ohio in Teacher Academy and ECE programs will be competing in 18 competitions.
