

# The Ohio State University Graduate Interdisciplinary Specialization in College and University Teaching

## Program Planning Form

*This form is to be utilized as a helpful guide in completing the Graduate Interdisciplinary Specialization in College and University Teaching.* An **official** application must be submitted on Gradforms for approval to be reviewed by the program unit and Graduate School. **Graduate Interdisciplinary Specialization** (requires a minimum of 10 credit hours, including 9 credit hours in a minimum of two program areas outside your home program). Interested students are encouraged to schedule an appointment with the Director to determine which courses to take to meet the requirements. 1. This Graduate Interdisciplinary Specialization involves **two or more graduate programs outside your primary graduate program** and requires a **minimum of 10 but no more than 20 credit hours** of graduate-level coursework. A **minimum of 9 hours must be taken outside your primary graduate program in at least 3 courses.**
2. These hours must include at least five (5) different courses and/or independent studies. A grade of B or better (or S when applicable) is required in each course comprising the specialization or minor. The graduate interdisciplinary specialization or the graduate interdisciplinary minor will appear on the student's transcript. (*Graduate School Handbook*, Section VII.4)
